Marymount University's Four-Year B.S.N. program consists of two years of nursing prerequisites and University/Liberal Arts Core (LAC) requirements followed by two years of courses in the nursing major. Nursing major courses begin in the fall only. Transfer students admitted to the program typically require one to two semesters of LAC courses before beginning the two years of the nursing major and would apply for fall or spring, depending upon the amount of prerequisite and LAC course work remaining.

Candidates must apply to the program through Marymount University's online application system at <https://apply.marymount.edu/apply>.

¹ *Submit all required documents by these deadlines.* (The application and fee should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the deadline listed above. Other documents are due by the deadline.) A completed application consists of the application itself, the \$40 application fee, official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended, one letter of recommendation, and ATI-TEAS test results.

² Upon notification, all accepted students must submit the \$300 enrollment deposit by specified deadline and register for classes at the earliest available opportunity (as determined by the Department of Nursing). Pertinent information will be included in the student's acceptance packet.

ATI-TEAS TESTING INFORMATION

The Assessment Technology Inc. Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI-TEAS), a nursing pre-admissions exam, must be completed by all nursing applicants before they can be considered by the Nursing Admissions Committee. The exam covers reading, math, science and English language usage. Applicants must earn satisfactory scores on the ATI-TEAS in order to be eligible for review by the Nursing Admissions Committee. Applicants who achieve an unsatisfactory score or who wish to improve their score may retake this exam only once. Please refer to the above chart for the ATI-TEAS testing dates at Marymount University. All tests are administered on Wednesday from 1:00 pm until 5:00 pm in Rowley Hall G221 on Marymount's Main Campus. Space is limited. Students must pre-register and pre-pay through the ATI website. The cost of the test is \$80.00. (The cost is subject to change at ATI's discretion.)
