Before you Arrive to Campus

- 1. Set up and access your [Marymount account](#).
- 2. Log in to your [Marymount Portal account](#), which has all the links you need including your new google Marymount e-mail account, Canvas, Marynet, and Orgsync. questions? Email its@marymount.edu. Provide a phone number so they can call you back.
- 3. Join the [MU International Student Group 18/19 on Facebook!](#) Ask questions, meet your peer advisors, and meet other new international students.
- 4. Read your pre-arrival guide, which includes all the information you need to get ready for your studies.
- 5. Submit your documents to [obtain an I-20](#) (F-1 visa students only).
- 6. Register for [New Student Orientation](#).
- 7. First year students take the [Directed Self-Placement \(DSP\)](#). Transfer and graduate students register for classes.
- 8. Apply for [housing](#).
- 9. Apply for the [F-1 visa](#) (if you are outside of the U.S.).
- 10. Book you flight - plan to arrive NO EARLIER THAN DECEMBER 14TH AND NO LATER THAN JANUARY 9TH.
- 11. Complete and upload your medical documents on the [medical portal](#).
- 12. Go to [Marynet](#) and pay your tuition or set up a payment plan.
- 13. Read all the Newsletters from the International Student Services Office!
