

Welcome to MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY!

All students are required to complete demographic, insurance information, and immunization history. All Marymount students born after December 31, 1956, must provide proof of compliance with immunization requirements mandated by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Marymount University. This form must be returned to the Student Health Center (SHC) by **August 1st** for the fall semester, **January 1st** for the spring semester and **May 1st** for the summer session. *This medical form is separate and in addition to any department specific requirements.* A registration block will result if all requirements are not met by the deadline. Records must be in English to ensure accuracy.

Acceptable documentation of immunization includes any of the following:

- ◆ Signature of a physician on the Immunization Record Form
- ◆ Copies of shot records
- ◆ Copies of medical records
- ◆ Copies of school health records

All information must be submitted in English, with dates of actual immunizations.

VACCINATIONS	WHO MUST COMPLY	COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS
Measels, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) (2 doses after age 1)	All students born after 1-Jan-57	Proof of vaccination
Tetanus-Diphtheria (within the last 10 years)	All students	Proof of vaccination
Hepatitis B series (3 doses)	All students	Proof of vaccination series or signed Hepatitis B Waiver
Meningitis (administered between ages 16-21)	All students age 22 and under	Proof of vaccination or signed Meningococcal Vaccine Waiver

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN A HOLD BEING PLACED ON FUTURE ENROLLMENT.

Marymount University requires all full-time students to carry adequate health insurance. Full-time is defined as 12 credits per semester for undergraduates and 9 credits per semester for graduate students (please note: in the summer session, 6 credits is considered full-time for graduate students). **At the start of each academic year, students will automatically be billed for the Marymount sponsored health insurance plan, unless proof of other insurance is provided by submission of an online insurance waiver.**

This insurance waiver is separate from the Student Medical Form and can be found online on www.marymount.edu/Student-Life/Health-Wellness/Student-Health-Center/Insurance-Waivers, or by visiting www.uhcsr.com/marymountu. If no action is taken and a waiver is not received by the current term's waiver deadlines, the student will be responsible for the premium.
