

## High School Completion Status

Provide one of the following documents that will indicate the student's high school completion status when the student begins college in 2020-2021:

- A copy of the student's high school diploma
- A copy of the student's final official high school transcript which shows the date when the diploma was awarded
- A GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other State-authorized examination, that the state recognizes as the equivalent to a high school diploma
- A copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document for students who completed their secondary education in a foreign country
- An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree
- A copy of a secondary school completion credential for homeschooled students if required by the state
- For a homeschooled student in a state where state law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting
