- Select Make FAFSA Corrections and navigate to the STUDENT INFORMATION section of the FAFSA form.
- Follow the instructions to determine if the student is eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer 2018 IRS income tax information. If ineligible, continue on to #2.
- 2. Request a tax return transcript from the IRS by calling 800-908-9946 OR You may submit your request online at https://www.irs.gov. Click on "Get Your Tax Record", then choose whether you want to get it online or by mail.
