What is the Marymount Faculty and Staff Fund?

Every year, faculty and staff demonstrate their dedication to Marymount University and its students by making gifts to the Faculty and Staff Fund. These gifts create an immediate and personal impact, enriching the lives of many students.

Why should I give to the Faculty and Staff Fund?

Whatever the reason, and whatever the designation, faculty and staff gifts to the University speak volumes to the rest of the community about Marymount as a place for philanthropic investment.

- Gifts provided by faculty and staff help to improve the quality of a Marymount education, expand available resources, and aid in recruiting and retaining top quality students, faculty, and staff.
- Tuition covers only **82%** of what it takes to educate our students. That means there is a 18 percent gap between tuition and fixed costs. Gifts provided by you help to fill this gap.
- Over 86% of Marymount undergraduates receive some form of financial aid
- Most importantly, **your participation counts**! It's not how much you give that matters, rather it's important that you participate.

Where can I designate my contribution?

<u>Faculty and Staff Scholarship</u>: This scholarship provides funding for current undergraduate students who show academic merit and financial need. Last year with your support we were able to raise over \$22,800 for the Faculty & Staff Scholarship which will provide funding for two undergraduate students and five graduate students this academic year.

<u>The Rhett Leverett Memorial Scholarship</u>: This scholarship was created in memory of Professor Leverett & in honor of his outstanding service to the University and its students as both a teacher and mentor. A member of Marymount's faculty since 1991, Professor Leverett will be remembered for many things including his kindness, his sense of humor, & his unfailing dedication.

<u>The Sean Hoare Memorial Scholarship</u>: This scholarship was created in memory of Dr. Sean Hoare, a professor of Literature & Languages since 1980. A respected and beloved member of Marymount, Dr. Hoare will be remembered for his scholarship, collegiality, and sage advice.

<u>The Saints Club</u>: The Saints Club is the home for all supporters of MU Athletics. Membership in the Saints Club supports the teams, the coaching staff, & helps power our sports teams by enhancing activities & training for our student-athletes.

<u>University's Primary Initiatives</u>: Gifts received in support of the University's primary initiatives ensure that Marymount is able to make the most of every situation while enriching the lives of faculty, staff, and Marymount students.
