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2014-15 Benchmarking Analysis Report Executive Summary

In Spring 2011, Marymount's Strategic Planning Committee (SPC) developed two lists of benchmark schools to provide a stronger comparison group for the University: (1) Peer Institutions and (2) Aspirant Institutions. The Peer Institutions group comprises those schools meeting the criteria set by the SPC on a host of institutional and student variables. First added to the 2010-11 edition of this report, the Aspirant Institutions group was derived using a smaller set of similar variables and some additional criteria. Note that Loyola University New Orleans and Saint Mary's College of California were previously in both benchmark groups, but after further examination have been considered solely Aspirant Institutions since the 2011-12 edition of this report.

A series of Marymount's defining characteristics were chosen to establish both the Peer Institutions and Aspirant Institutions lists. First, Marymount's *Peer Institutions* were determined based on the same characteristics as in 2011, including:

After identifying the two benchmarking institution groups, the SPC developed a list of topics that would be useful as it gauges Marymount's progress on addressing the new strategic plan. Issues revolve around five major areas: (1) Enrollment and the Student Body; (2) Retention and Graduation; (3) Academic Experience and Programs; (4) Student Life Offerings; and (5) Financial and Operational Issues.

Data and Analysis:

The Office of Planning and Institutional Effectiveness was tasked with compiling available data and information relating to the SPC's specific topics. This report draws on a variety of sources, including the *Integrated Postsecondary Educational Data System (IPEDS)* from the U.S. Department of Education; *U.S. News & World Report*; the *Common Data Set*; and in some cases the institutions' websites. Quantitative data are generally from the 2014-15 academic year. The median (midpoint) for the benchmarking groups is presented and used to reflect institutions' overall performance on the measure. Use of any other statistics (e.g., five-year average) is noted in the text of the finding.

Major Findings:

Enrollment and the Student Body

- Marymount has a higher concentration of graduate students than its Peers.
- Marymount has more transfer students entering than its Peers or Aspirants.
- Marymount's undergraduates are as traditional (under the age of 25 and enrolling full-time) as its Peers, but much less so than its Aspirants, particularly regarding age.
- Marymount's graduate students are more likely than those of its Peers to be under the age of 25 and enrolling full-time, and equally as likely as those of its Aspirants.
- Marymount lags behind its Peers and Aspirants in undergraduate males only slightly.
- At the graduate level, Marymount's gender distribution of one-fourth male students is nearly equal to its Peers but less than its Aspirants with one-third male students.
- Both of Marymount's undergraduate and graduate student populations are more racially and ethnically diverse than those of its Peers or Aspirants.
- Over the last five years, Marymount's very small (1%) average increase in undergraduate enrollment is equal to the median growth of its Peers and Aspirants.
- Marymount's graduate enrollment decreased at a faster rate than its Peers and Aspirants since 2010.
- On average, Marymount is less selective in accepting first-college applicants than its Peers or Aspirants, though it enrolls slightly less of these applicants than its Peers and only slightly more than its Aspirants.
- Marymount's entering students' total SAT scores are 5 points above the median for its Peers but 95 points below its Aspirants.

Retention and Graduation

- Marymount's five-year average retention rate of full-time, first-time undergraduates is just under the median rate for its Peers and substantially below its Aspirants.

- Marymount has a lower four-, five-, and six-year graduation rate than its Peers and Aspirants.
- Marymount shares a 53% average six-year graduation rate with its Peers, but falls 15 percentage points short of its Aspirants' average rate over the last five years.
- Marymount produces more bachelor's and master's degree graduates than its Peers, but only more master's degree graduates compared to its Aspirants.

Academic Experience and Programs

- Marymount is the only school among its Peers or Aspirants to award a high proportion of its total bachelor's degrees in the visual arts/design fields, though one-third of its Aspirants count bachelor's degrees awarded in the performing arts among their top five.
- Twelve (12) of Marymount's Peers and all of its Aspirants offer bachelor's degrees in foreign languages, particularly French and Spanish.
- Marymount is unique for requiring an internship for all undergraduates, while only one of its Peers and two of its Aspirants require an internship *or similar experience*.
- Service-Learning is required of all undergraduates at two of Marymount's Peers and at four of its Aspirants.
- Marymount offers more study abroad countries with approved programs than the median of its Peer or Aspirant group.
- Like Marymount, one-third of its Peers have a formal center or institute with a Health/Wellness mission, while only two of its Aspirants has such center or institute.
- Marymount has more full-time faculty than its Peers but less than its Aspirants.
- Marymount's full-time faculty is more likely to be female than its Peers or Aspirants.

Student Life Offerings

- Marymount is less likely than its Peers or Aspirants to offer performing arts opportunities.
- Unlike most of its Peers and Aspirants, Marymount does not have a school radio station.
- A majority of the Peer and Aspirant Institutions have their own television station, which Marymount also lacks.
- While Marymount offers men's and women's triathlon unlike all of its Peers and only one of its Aspirants, institutions in both benchmark groups more commonly offer tennis and/or track and field for men and women.
- The percentage of undergraduate students engaged in campus employment (excluding Federal Work Study) at Marymount is substantially under the rate at both its Peers and Aspirants, but Marymount students earn more per year than the median average annual earnings of students at both benchmark groups.

Financial and Operational Issues

- Marymount's total cost is just above that of its Peers and below its Aspirants.
- Room and board charges at Marymount exceed its Peers and are equal to its Aspirants.
- Since 2010-11, Marymount's tuition has risen on pace (4%) with its Peers and Aspirants.
- Marymount has fewer students with Pell Grants than its Peers.
- The percentage of full-time, first-time freshmen at Marymount taking out loans is less than its Peers and Aspirants.

- Marymount's three-year average endowment per FTE enrollment (\$11,665) is greater than the median of its Peers (\$9,788) and about one-fourth the size of its Aspirants (\$40,933).
- Marymount continues to have a slightly better reputation than its Peers but a less favorable one than its Aspirants, according to the *U.S. News & World Report* survey.
- Marymount saw a sharp average percent decrease (-13%) in undergraduate alumni giving that was more than twice the decrease of its Peers and four times that of its Aspirants.
- Approximately half (48%) of Marymount's total expenses are for instruction and academic support, which is 4% more than its Peers and 3% less than its Aspirants spend.
