- 1. Set up and access your Marymount account
- 2. Log in to your Marymount Portal account which has access to all the applications you need. Including your new google Marymount email account, Canvas, Marynet, Handshake and Engage.
- 3. Joint the MU International Student Group 19/20 on Facebook! Ask questions, meet your peer advisor and other new international students.
- **4**. Read your **pre-arrival guide**, which includes all the information you need to get ready for your studies.
- 5. Submit your documentation to **obtain an I-20** (F-1 visa students only)
- 6. Pay the Sevis Fee (Initial I-20 only)
- 7. Apply for the F-1 Visa (If you're outside the U.S)
- 8. Register for New Student orientation
- **9.** First year students take the **Directed Self-Placement (DSP)** Transfer and Graduate students contact your program school for academic advising.
- **10.** Apply for **Housing**
- 11. Book your flight to the U.S Plan to arrive NO EARLIER THAN 12/08 AND NO LATER THAN 01/08
- 12. Upload your medical documents on the Medical portal
- 13. Go to Marynet (MU Portal) and pay your tuition or set up a payment plan.
- **14.** Read the International Student Services News e-mails.
